

Proposed regents' bylaw change

Sec. 11.53. The School of Social Work: The Executive Committee

The executive committee will consist of the

dean and six members of the governing faculty, five tenured and one un-tenured member of the professorial staff, to be appointed by the board on recommendation by the president. The appointed tenured members will hold office for three years, and the appointed un-tenured member will hold office for two years. The terms will be adjusted so that no more than two tenured appointments will expire each year. The appointed members will not be eligible for reappointment until after the lapse of one year. The dean will chair the committee.
